ORDER REVOKING CERTAIN LOCAL RULES

AND RENUMBERING OTHERS

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the Court that certain Local rules are no longer applicable, and

WHEREAS, the Court recognizes that the Rules of Judicial Administration direct that local rules are to be sequentially numbered and those previously adopted in this circuit have **not been**, it is

ORDERED that:

Local Rule 1.3 titled **Organization of County Court of Polk County, Florida**, and approved by the Florida Supreme Court on December 18, 1978, is hereby **REVOKED**.

Local Rule 8 titled **Alternate Method of Jury Selection**, approved by the Florida Supreme Court on December 18, 1978, and **Amendment Number One** thereto, approved January 23, 1979, are hereby **REVOKED**.

Local Rules 8.2, titled **Preparation of Jury List**; 8.3, titled **Security**; 8.4, titled **Venire Selection**; 8.5, titled **Permissive Use**; and the unnumbered rule, titled **Costs in Traffic Infraction Cases**, all approved by The Florida Supreme Court on December 18, 1978, are hereby **REVOKED**.

Local Rule 3 titled **Designation of Driver Schools**, approved by The Florida Supreme Court on July 16, 1979, is hereby **REVOKED**.

Local Rule 8-92 titled **Selection of Jurors by Computer in Polk County**, approved by The Florida Supreme Court on October 19, 1992, is hereby **renumbered as Tenth Judicial Circuit Local Rule Number 2**.

Local Rule 9-92a titled **Selection of Jurors by Computer in Hardee County**, approved by the Florida Supreme Court on October 19, 1992, is hereby renumbered as **Tenth Judicial Circuit Court Local Rule Number 3**.

Previously submitted, but **not yet approved** by the Florida Supreme Court, Local Rule Number 1, titled **Courts of the Tenth Judicial Circuit of Florida: Implemenation Rule**, shall be known, **upon approval**, as **Tenth Judicial Circuit Local Rule Number 1**.
