**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 3-27.0**

**IN RE: RE-ASSIGNMENT OF PROFESSIONAL MALPRACTICE CASES  
AND EMINENT DOMAIN CASES TO CIVIL DIVISION SECTIONS**

**ORDERED that effective March 1, 2002, the Clerk of Court shall comply with the following procedures:**

1. All eminent domain cases currently assigned to sections 04, 07, and 11 shall be re-assigned to section 08.

2. All professional malpractice cases currently assigned to section 08 shall be re-assigned to sections 04, 07, and 11, with section 11 receiving three shares and sections 04 and 07 receiving five shares each.

3. All newly filed eminent domain cases shall be assigned only to section 08.

4. All newly filed professional malpractice cases shall be assigned to sections 04, 07, and 11, with section 11 receiving three shares and sections 04 and 07 receiving five shares each.
