SERVICE CHARGES BY CLERKS OF THE CIRCUIT COURT

Section 28.24 of the Florida Statutes requires, in part, that Clerks of the Circuit Court make specific monetary charges when making and providing copies of any instrument in the public records. The purpose of such charges was not intended to extend to copies of instruments needed for official judicial purposes. It is therefore

ORDERED THAT

1. The Clerks of the Circuit Court are specifically authorized and directed to provide, without charge, to Parole and Probation Supervisors of the Tenth Judicial Circuit copies of the following instruments: information, warrant, affidavit and file index.
  2. The Clerks of the Circuit Court are further authorized and directed to make and provide, without charge, copies of official instruments for the Circuit and County Judges, State Attorney, and Public Defender of the Tenth Judicial Circuit, upon request for their official use.
  3. The authorization contained herein may be extended by schedules hereafter promulgated.
  4. Administrative Order No. 26.1 is hereby canceled.
