**SPECIAL ORDER**

**VACATING ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 6-2.0  
AND  
REASSIGNING JUVENILE DELINQUENCY CASES  
DESIGNATED AS DIVISION J-3 TO DIVISION J-2 CASES**

WHEREAS, Administrative Order No. 6-2.0 requires the Polk County Clerk of Courts to assign juvenile delinquency cases to one of two divisions, Division J-2 or Division J-3, and

WHEREAS, it is no longer necessary to assign juvenile delinquency cases to multiple divisions, as only one judge is currently assigned to preside over all juvenile delinquency cases in Polk County, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the juvenile delinquency cases designated as Division J-3 be reassigned to Division J-2 in order to promote judicial economy, maximize judicial resources, and provide for prompt and efficient administration of justice in this circuit, it is therefore

ORDERED that Administrative Order No. 6-2.0, entitled *Providing System for Impartial Assignment of Juvenile Delinquency Cases*, entered on September 14, 1992, is hereby **VACATED**. The Polk County Clerk of Courts shall reassign all juvenile delinquency cases currently designated as Division J-3 to Division J-2. The Polk County Clerk of Courts is further ORDERED and DIRECTED to immediately cease assigning cases to Division J-3.
