The Mission of Polk County Problem Solving Courts D.U.I. Drug Court Program

The D.U.I. Drug Court provides judicial oversight, probated supervision and intense outpatient treatment to keep repeat D.U.I. Offenders sober. Using a "one Judge, one team" strategy that blends the expertise of the judge, prosecutors, defense attorneys, treatment providers and probation officers, the D.U.I. Drug Court governs offender compliance and progress.

Upon acceptance of the offender's plea to the D.U.I. charge, the offender is placed on supervised probation. During this time, the D.U.I. offender is required to comply with the statutory requirements of Florida Statues 316.193 and 322.28 and complete all phases of D.U.I. Drug Court.

Phase l Requirements Misdemeanor/3 Months Felony/7 Months

- Bi-weekly court appearances.
- Attend a minimum of one 90 minute education group per week.
- Attend a minimum of one 60 minute individual therapy session per month.
- Attend a minimum of three Support Group meetings per week. Additional meetings may be required upon treatment team recommendation.
- Submit to random alcohol and/or drug screens.
- Call Color Line daily at (863) 534-5828.
- Comply with additional requirements recommended by the treatment team.
- Pay all fees/costs associated with the program.

Phase ll Requirements Misdemeanor/5 Months Felony/10 Months

- Court appearances as ordered.
- Attend a minimum of one 90 minute treatment group per week.
- ◆ Attend a minimum of one 60 minute individual therapy session per month.
- Attend a minimum of three Support Group meetings per week. Additional meetings may be required upon treatment team recommendation.
- Submit to random alcohol and/or drug screens.
- ♦ Call Color Line daily at (863) 534-5828.
- Comply with additional requirements recommended by the treatment team.
- Pay all fees/costs associated with the program.
- Obtain a Support Group sponsor prior to progression into Phase III.

Phase Ill Requirements Misdemeanor/4 Months Felony/7 Months

- Court appearances as ordered.
- Attend a minimum of one 90 minute treatment group session bi-weekly.
- ◆ Attend a minimum of one 60 minute individual therapy session per month.
- Attend a minimum of three Support Group meetings per week. Additional meetings may be required upon treatment team recommendation.
- Submit to random alcohol and/or drug screens.
- Comply with additional requirements recommended by the treatment team.
- Relapse prevention will be addressed at least 1 hour during group and/or individual sessions.
- Maintain frequent contact with Support Group sponsor.
- Develop a relapse prevention plan.
- Pay all fees/costs associated with the program.
